#### **Welcome and Introductions:**

#### **Charge to the Committee - Dr. Campbell**

History on how committee came into being:

Last year a steering committee was convened to work with Parthenon and co-chaired by Dr. Hibbard and Danny Flanigan to look at business operations and business analysis and come forward with recommendations. The top recommendation was to develop a technology governance committee to oversee major technology issues in the College. Recognizing that technology is pervasive, there is not one single part of the campus not impacted by technology and it needs to be integrated more deliberately. Some disjointedness we experience could be in the way we are organized and has nothing to do with technology.

Discussions this committee will hold: What constitutes a campus wide technology decision? What technology should come to this committee for a decision?

Committee co-chairs Delores Barton, MIT/CIO and Myra Burnett, Chief Academic officer will guide the committee through the conversations regarding what decisions should come here and what the committee wants to accomplish this semester and next year.

### **Discussion on upgrades to technology verses new technology**

1. Create complete database of technology on campus - Service Catalog  
Information on license agreements, including what is the term per user and product. Primarily for informational purposes.
2. Broad impact purchases should come to TGC, such as:
  - Upgrades etc.; could involve replacing widely-used software (e.g., Moodle)
  - Banner Optimization
  - Email Client
  - Lotus Database (application side)
  - Budgeting tools for annual and long range planning
  - Moodle or other Learning Management System
