

TECHNOLOGY GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE CHARGE

The Technology Governance Committee oversees major technology purchases, policies and priorities in the College. Two major activities include:

1. Creating a complete database of technology on campus accessible through a Service Catalog within the mySpelman portal. Information will include information on license agreements, including the term per user and product, who is currently using specific technology on campus, and comments from end users (primarily for informational purposes)
2. Prioritizing and providing approvals on broad impact purchases, such as:
 - Upgrading/replacing existing widely-used software
 - Banner Optimization
 - Email Client
 - Lotus Database (application side)
 - Budgeting tools for annual and long range planning
 - Moodle or other Learning Management Systems

Advisory Committees

Three advisory committees will support the work of the Technology Governance Committee:

Educational Technology Committee (Faculty)

Staff Technology Advisory Committee

Student Technology Advisory Committee

Each advisory committee is charged with informing the TGC of stakeholder concerns, making recommendations regarding technology purchases/improvements, responding to communications from the TGC, and maintaining transparent and effective channels of communication between the TGC and the campus stakeholders.

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
