

DISCLOSURE FOR SOFTWARE AND MULTIMEDIA WORKS

1. **Definitions:** Software and multimedia works include any work that has resulted in a program, utility, algorithm, multimedia material, or any software that may have potential commercial value. Any work of this nature is herein referred to as the Program.

A. Name: Please provide a name for the Program. The name should be unique and descriptive as to what function the Program performs. An acronym may be used as a name.

B. Costs and Funding: Identify any sponsored funding and applicable grant numbers that are associated with the development of the Program. Please estimate what costs have been involved to date in the work leading to the development of the Program.

C. Developers: For each individual involved in the development of the Program, regardless the level of contribution, please provide the following information:

1. Full legal name
2. Residential address, including street, city, zip code, and county.
3. Country of citizenship.
4. Personal phone number.
5. E-mail address, including both a school address and a personal address.

D. Description: Please provide a brief description of the Program and the purposes for which it may be used. Please identify any proprietary copyright or trademark data that has been used in development of the Program. Please identify if a release for such use is needed and has been granted by the appropriate third party.

E. Comparable Programs: Please identify what program, if any, that serves the same or similar purpose as this Program. Please identify all commercial, freeware, and shareware programs as appropriate. Please describe the novel aspects of your Program, including how it differs from other software available on the market.

F. Functional Description of the Program: Please provide the following details:

1. Computers and devices on which the Program will operate.
2. Programming language used to develop the program.
3. Operating system used to develop the program.
4. Identify other software, if any, necessary to run the Program.
5. Identify if a user manual is available for the Program. Please attach a copy of the user manual or other current documentation, if available.
6. Identify if the Program may be used off-the-shelf or must be customized for use by each customer.
7. Identify the anticipated distribution for the Program, including open

license, beta test license, academic use license, company license, and/or software reseller license.

8. Identify what, if any, future development is anticipated for the Program.
