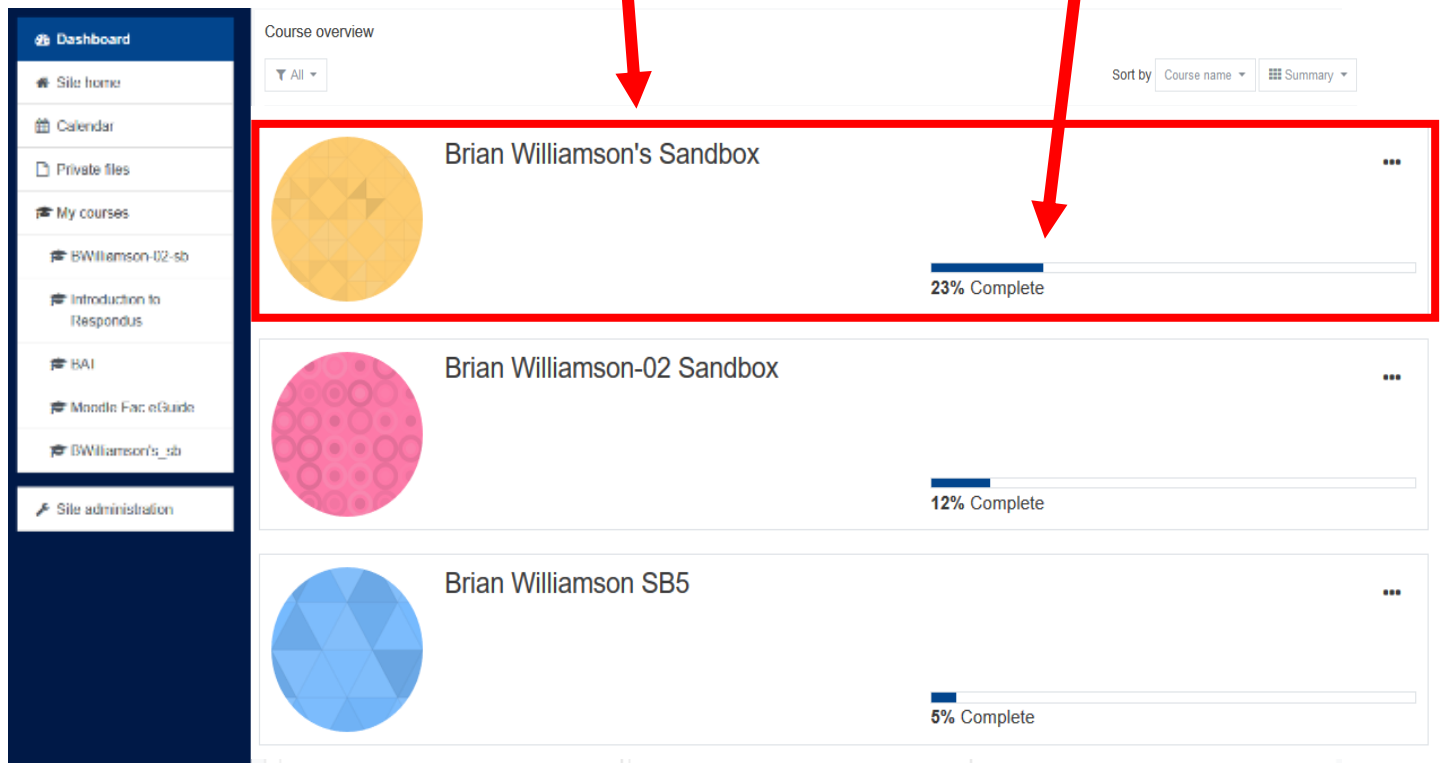
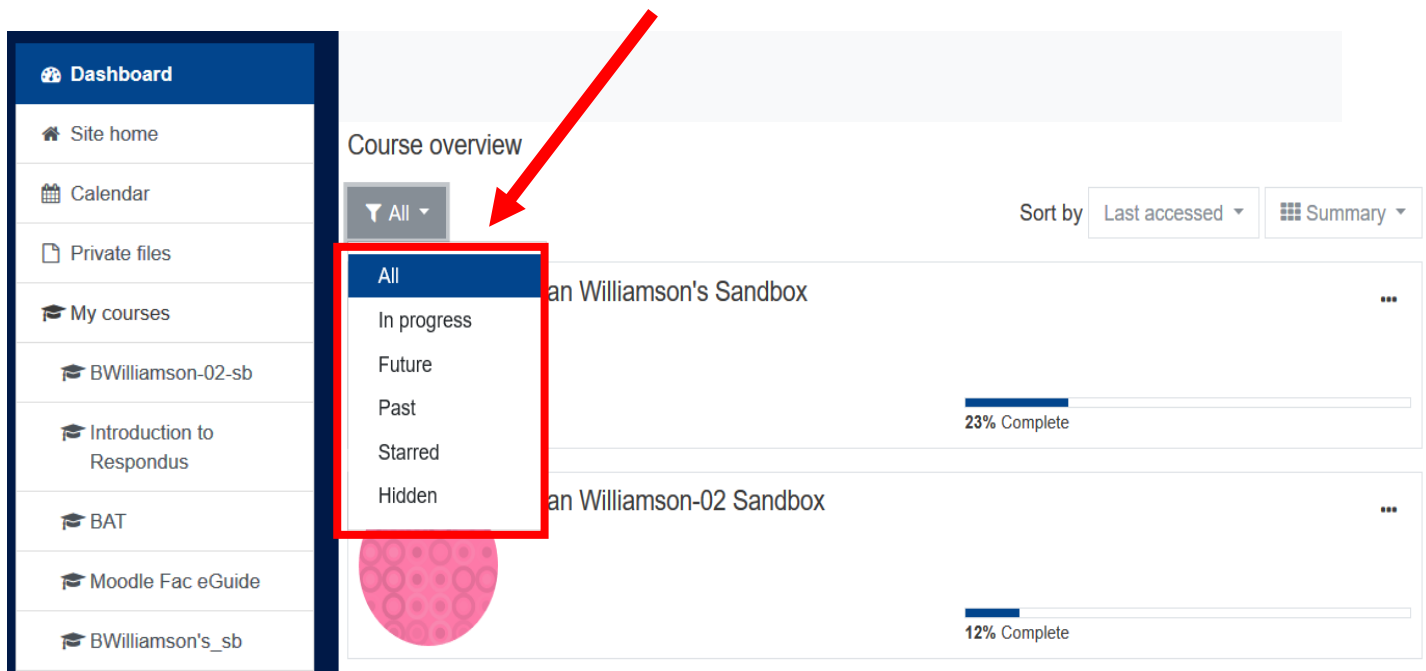

1. Default Dashboard has new Summary format look as well as course completion percentage

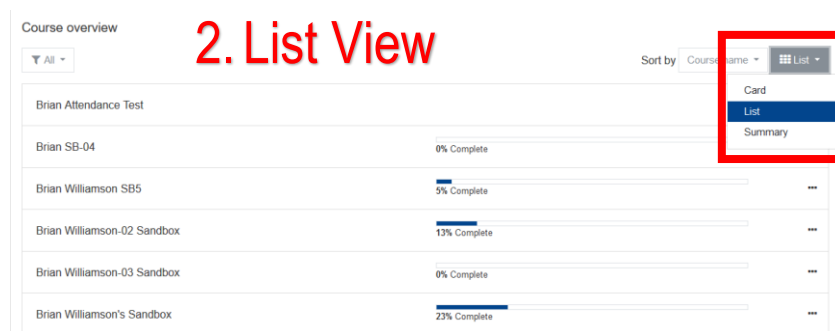
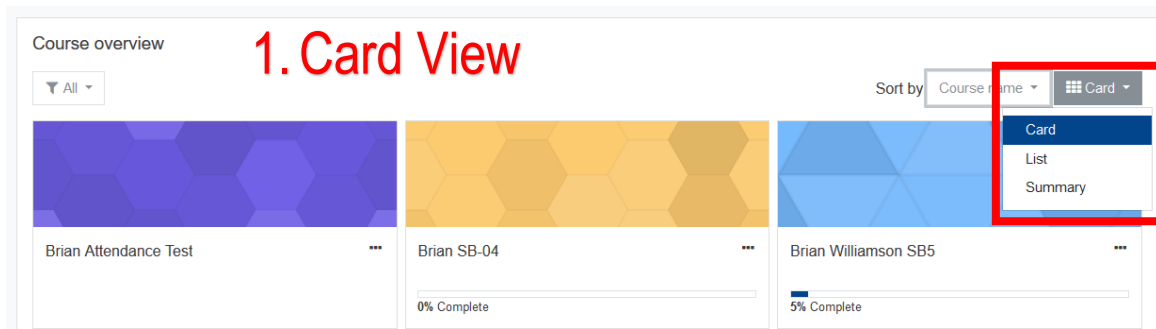

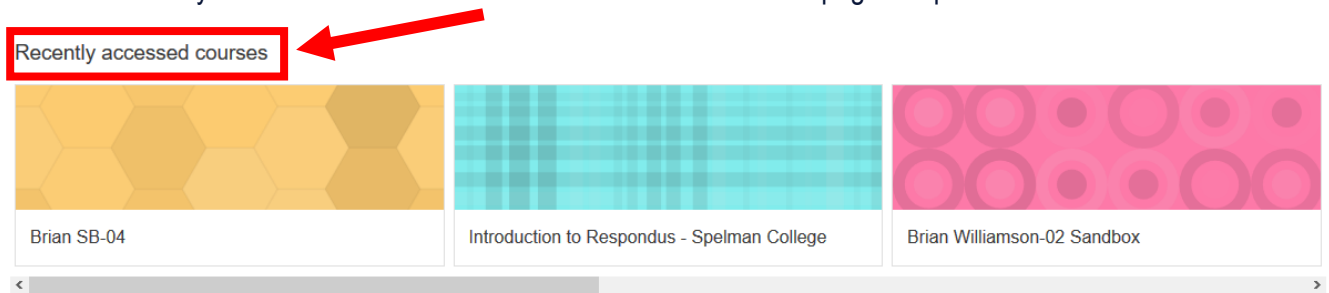





- File type specification improvements including a list of file type suggestions
- Inspire Analytics – an analytics engine in core Moodle that helps you identify students at risk and target appropriately.
- New Privacy and policies links help meet [GDPR](#) requirements
- Course images now appear on the dashboard
- Clearer icons and accessible fonts
- Record sound and video within Atto editor
- More efficient user management options on the Participants page
- Award badges based on other badges and other new criteria options
- Tags may be added and filtered directly in the Question bank
- Ability to add file attachments to Essay questions
- Improvements to the Moodle Mobile App
- Improvements to the Dashboard and Course Overview page.
